



## HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT OF INTENT

The BGB Group will review the H&S policy to ensure it is relevant, suitable and sufficient for the work undertaken by the company, is compliant with all required legislation necessary and reviewed at least annually to continually improve health and safety.
